

**MINUTES

JANUARY 12, 2023**

1.0 Call To Order 5:30 P.M.

The Beer Board of the City of Springfield met in regular session on January 12, 2023 at City Hall.

Board members present: Chairman Joe Donald King, Deann Pigott, Walt Hannabass, Mike Wilhoit, Dontez Huskey, and Gina Holt

1.1 Approval of minutes from the regular meeting on December 8, 2022.

Ms. Holt moved to approve the minutes as written and ordered filed. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wilhoit and passed unanimously.

2.0 Administrative

2.1 Discussion and action on the following business cited for violating Chapter 8 of the City of Springfield Municipal Code.

Permit Holder: Emad Henary

Business: Sam Market

Address: 202 Central Avenue East #A

Detective Chad Clinard of the Springfield Police Department was present.

Mr. Henary, permit holder, was present. Attorney Stephen Wayne Duncan, Jr., with The Law Office of Joe R. "Jay" Johnson, II, who represented Mr. Henary, was also present.

This was a first offense.

Mr. Wilhoit moved for 15-day suspension with the option to pay a \$2,500 civil penalty in lieu of suspension. If the permit holder chooses not to pay the civil penalty, the suspension would become effective 30 days from today. The civil penalty if chosen must be paid within 7 days. The motion was seconded by Mr. Huskey and passed a 6-0 roll call vote.

The deadline for payment of the civil penalty is Thursday, January 19, 2023. If payment is not received, the 15-day suspension will go into effect.

- 2.2 Discussion and action on the following business cited for violating Chapter 8 of the City of Springfield Municipal Code.

Permit Holder: Joseph Metry
Business: Daniel's
Address: 308 Memorial Boulevard

Detective Chad Clinard of the Springfield Police Department was present.
Mr. Metry failed to appear before the board despite a certified notice being sent.

Mr. Hannabass moved to find the permit holder guilty of the 2nd offense violation, however, due the fact that the permit has since been surrendered, the board is unable to impose a suspension or revocation. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wilhoit and passed a 6-0 roll call vote.
